INVITATION & RULES

GENERAL INFORMATION

DATE & VENUE

The event will be held on **Saturday 22nd October 2022** Ravenscraig Regional Sports Facility, 1 O'Donnell Way, Motherwell, North Lanarkshire.

PARTICIPATION

The Paddy Timoney remembrance Cup is an open event. This means clubs from any affiliation are welcome to participate at this event. NOTE: If you are not an ITF Scotland affiliated school, please familiarise yourself with the rules in this document and the official rules from the ITF website: <u>https://itftkd.sport/wpcontent/uploads/2022/04/Official-ITF-Rules-of-Competition-Version-2022v1.pdf</u>, as these will be the rules in place at the event.

REGISTRATION OF SCHOOLS AND CLUBS

Please note: Registration may close early depending on the number of entries received.

CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION - IMPORTANT

The Paddy Timoney Remembrance Cup will only accept registrations from schools and clubs that supply the appropriate number of umpires. Each school must participate with FULL TIME UMPIRE(S) according to the following:

•	1 to 10 competitors	1 Umpire
•	11 to 20 competitors	2 Umpires
•	21 to 30 competitors	3 Umpires
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• 30 competitors or more 4 Umpires

Full Time umpires should be Blackbelts who are available for the duration of the event.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Please be aware that in order to register competitors for the event, you must first register your umpires. All competitors will be held on a waiting list for approval until umpires are registered to the event.

COACHES

It is permitted to have a coach present at the event, **as long as the club meets the umpire to competitor ratio**. They may have the following number of coaches:

- 1 to 5 competitors 1 Coach
- 6 to 10 competitors 2
- 11 to 20 competitors
- 21 to 30 competitors
- 30 competitors or more

A coach must be a training, licensed member of your school.

Coach Fee is £15 per coach.

ACCREDITATION

All competitors, coaches and umpire's entry will be by ID card. Spectators will have entry tracked by a wristband. The wristbands will be available to purchase at the door.

INSCRIPTION

All ID cards and wristbands should be collected first at inscription. This will be at the same times and venue as the weigh-in.

Coach ID cards will be only be issued on the morning of the event but only if the umpire quota has been confirmed.

REGISTRATION - WEIGHT / HEIGHT CHECK

All competitors MUST register at the official registrations listed below bringing their ID card with them for scanning. Any competitor not registering will be scored out on the drawsheet and be unable to compete.

The weight / height check will take place at Ravenscraig Regional Sports Facility during the following times:

Friday 21 st October	from 6-9pm (any competitor)
Saturday 22 nd October	from 8-9am (any competitor)

It is highly recommended that competitors complete height / weight check on the Friday evening, to allow for any category changes to be made. **No category changes will take place on the Saturday morning**. If a student does not make height / weight they will be removed from the category. Please ensure you double check your height / weight when registering for the event.

During weigh in ALL competitors must wear dobok trousers and t-shirt. A weight tolerance of 0.5kg is given.

CONFIRMATION OF COMPETITOR DETAILS

It is solely the responsibility of the instructor to verify that their students' details are correct and they have been placed in the correct categories.

There will be no changes made to categories on the day of the competition. If they are entered incorrectly, they will miss out on their correct category event.

Therefore, if your competitors intend to complete the registration on the day of competition there will be no allowance to make any category change. Should your competitors not make the height / weight category accordingly they will be removed from that event.

We encourage all competitors to complete the height and weight check on the Friday evening, to allow any changes to be made if required.

OFFICIAL ATTIRE

ATHLETES

As this is an open event all dobok styles will be allowed.

All blackbelt competitor belts must show their current degree, variations of calligraphy will be allowed.

All Kup grades must have a single colour belt with tags on either end, or a full colour striped belt.

Competitors in Kids programmes within their school, may wear their kids programme uniform, with the equivalent ITF Taekwon-do belt.

COACHES

All coaches must also wear a tracksuit, training shoes and towel. The official ITF Tournament rules provides official details of coach attire.

UMPIRES

BLACKBELT Umpires and Jury Members should wear official ITF umpire attire:

- Navy Jacket and Trousers
- White shirt
- Blue tie no instructor colours (RED / GOLD ETC..)
- White shoes and socks

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Compulsory equipment

- Closed finger, Open palm sparring gloves
- Foot protection
- Head protection
- Gum shield
- Groin guard (Males only)

Optional Equipment

- Body Armour (10 years and under)
- Shin guards
- Chest Protectors (Female)
- Groin Guard (Female)

TOURNAMENT RULES

ITF rules will apply with modifications to suit age, experience, and gender.

DIVISIONS & CATEGORIES

AGE GROUPS

The competition will be divided into the following age divisions:

- Youth 0-7 years
- Cadets 8-10 years
- Pre-Jnr 11-13 years
- Jnr 14-17 years
- Senior 18-35 years
- Adv Snr 36+ years
- ASN Jnr/Snr

AGE GROUPS

All categories will be split male and female.

BELT COLOUR GROUPS

Please refer to all categories for specific bandings of colours.

ENTRIES

There must be at least two (2) competitors in any division and /or category. In case of only one (1) competitor, the organising committee reserve the right to merge the competitor to another category.

PATTERN

COLOURED BELTS

The competitors will perform **one optional** pattern according to their grade, up to and including the final:

- Elementary TKD: 4 Punches forward & backwards in Walking Stance
- White Belt: Saju-Jirugi / Saju-Makgi / Chon-Ji
- Yellow Belt: Dan-Gun / Do-San
- Green Belt: Won-Hyo / Yul Gok
- Blue Belt: Joong-Gun / Toi Gye
- Red Belt: Hwa-Rang / Choong-Moo

Please note: 'Elementary TKD' is aimed at students within Kids Programmes, that haven't yet learned an ITF Taekwon-do Pattern. Students Should wear a belt that is white in colour.

BLACK BELTS

Competitors will perform **one designated** pattern according to their grade, up to and including the final:

- 1st Degree: Kwang-Gae / Po-Eun / Ge-Baek
- 2nd Degree: Eui-Am / Choong-Jang / Juche
- 3rd Degree: Sam-IL / Yoo-Sin / Choi-Yong
- 4th 6th Degree: Yong-gae / Ul-Ji / Moon-Moo

ADDITIONAL SUPPORT NEEDS

In the rounds, the competitors will perform **optional** pattern according to their grade.

The division may be split by grades on the day of the event.

PERFORMANCE NOTES:

In the case of a draw:

Both competitors will be given a designated pattern from Chon-Ji up to the limit of the lowest grade competing, excluding any pattern that was performed in the first pattern. White belts may perform the same pattern again.

SPARRING

CATEGORIES DEFINED BY HEIGHT

YOUTH	<120CM, <130CM, >130CM
CADETS	<130CM, <140CM, <150CM, >150CM
PRE-JNR	<150CM, <160CM, <170CM, >170CM

NB: <120cm means it's up to and including 120cm. <130cm means over 120.1cm and up to 130cm.

BELT COLOUR GROUPS FOR HEIGHT DEFINED CATEGORIES

YOUTH, CADETS AND PRE-JUNIOR will be split both MALE and FEMALE with following belt colour groups:

- White Yellow Belt
- Blue Green Belt
- Red Black Belt

CATEGORIES DEFINED BY WEIGHT

JUNIORS will compete in the following belt colour groupings:

- White Green Belt
- Blue Red Belt
- Black Belt

The following weight categories will apply for Junior Kup Grades:

- Male <56KG, <68KG, >68KG
- Female <56KG, <68KG, >68KG

The following weight categories will apply for Junior Black Belts:

- Male <50KG, <56KG, <62KG, <68KG, <75KG, >75KG
- Female <45KG, <50KG, <55KG, <60KG, <65KG, >65KG

NB: <56kg means it's up to and including 56kg. <62kg means over 56.1kg and up to 62kg.

SENIOR and ADV SENIOR will compete in the following belt colour groupings:

- White Green Belt
- Blue- Red Belt
- Black Belt

The following weight categories will apply for Senior Kup Grades:

- Male <63KG, <78KG, >78KG
- Female <55KG, <65KG, >65KG

The following weight categories will apply for Senior Black Belts:

- Male <57KG, <63KG, <70KG, <78KG, <85KG, >85KG
- Female <50KG, <56KG, <62KG, <68KG, <75KG, >75KG

The following weight categories will apply for Adv Senior Kup and Black Belts:

- Male <78KG, <85KG, >85KG
- Female <68KG, <75KG, >75KG

Additional Support Needs

Will be split according to height/weight on the day.

SPARRING FORMAT

All categories will be in continuous sparring format. There will be no point stop sparring.

SPARRING MATCH DURATION

Unless stated all time periods are for elimination rounds and finals. All matches if resulting in a draw will conclude in a 1st point deciding round.

CADETS: All grades will be 1 x 60 secs.

YOUTH & PRE-JUNIOR All grades will be 1 x 90 secs.

JUNIOR: Kup Grades will be 1 x 120 secs. Black Belts will be 1 x 120 secs. Black Belt Finals will be 1 x 180 secs

SENIOR: Kup Grades will be 1 x 120 secs. Black Belts will be 1 x 120 secs. Black Belt Finals will be 1 x 180 secs

ADV SENIOR: Kup Grades and Blackbelt will be 1 x 120 secs.
